## Welcome, President's Report, Aurora Milstein

- Welcome to the 2019-2020 School Year

- Spirit Gear
  - We still have insulated water bottles, hats, car magnets, and some smaller sized shirts!
- Soaring Hawk Scramble Fun Run
  - Assembly is August 22 at 2:30
  - Scramble Fun Run is August 29 during your child(ren)'s specials time: Come on out and cheer!
  - Goal is \$16,000 net this is an average of \$30 per student, which will earn every class a party with inflatables
  - We have budgeted to make the same as last year
  - We are hoping to increase our participation from 48% to 100%!
  - We hope to use direct communication from the teachers to parents to encourage the fundraising
- Fundraising Goals:
  - Outdoor improvements: Shade Structure/ Accessible playground equipment/ landscaping/ building projects:
    - Proposed goal of \$10,000 to complete installation of accessible equipment
  - Teacher Grants
    - Proposed budget to distribute \$7,000 in grants for 2019-2020 school year (Grants occur in three month windows each semester. A staff member may only receive one approved grant per semester)
  - Kindness Decor
    - Bathroom stalls
    - Little reminders throughout the building- quotes and signs to encourage community members to be kind
  - Student Assemblies and Field Trips
    - Fifth Grade fundraising for AVID Field Trip
      - The reason for this is that Douglas County will not let us use district transit for extended day field trip. We have to use charter buses, which increases the cost significantly. By having fifth grade teams raise money, we will add this to a special fund that will help reduce the cost
        - Concern about the small percentage of parents who will be involved and do the fundraising, and it will not go very far
        - Potentially using the Holiday Shop as the fundraiser and parent volunteers leveraged by teachers
        - Encourage participation through the grade-level platforms
  - General Fund: Any funds raised above and beyond fundraising goals (or otherwise not stated as
    a specified goal) will go toward our general fund and will be voted on by the PTO community
    as need arises.
    - General Fund goes toward teacher grants, snack cart, community events, Welcome Committee, and covering expenses
- We are hoping room parents can help us promote events through their grade/ classroom app

- Explanation of new budget format
  - We took a more conservative approach to our budget this year
  - Numbers are based on income over the last year or two
  - Holiday Shop is blank because we do not have anyone to chair it
- We are trying to take a more student-centric approach on our spending this year
  - The largest expense will be the installation of the accessible equipment
  - We would like to bring in special speakers for assemblies, promoting kindness and habits of character: plays from Colorado Shakespeare; Drops in the Bucket Program
    - Question posed as to bringing in military speakers
    - Adding community events similar to Food Truck Friday possibly adding that to something like the speaker
  - Question posed of maybe saving this year to pay for more of AVID next year
    - At this point our budget will not allow for that, but it is a consideration once we see our numbers at the end of the year
