The bank balance as of 11/30/2016 is \$19,423.58. Have about \$8,500 to spend for the year. Will give \$3,000 to school to cover bus fees for field trips. May add to that before the end of the year.

Monica also said that Butter Braids went well. It brought it about \$9,000, which is \$3,000 profit.
