Teacher Grant Vote

- Erin presented several grant requests from staff. All four board members voted to approve the following grants...
 - o Amanda Gutierrez (Speech) \$300 for an online social/emotional speech program APPROVED
 - Monica Allen (Reading) \$2,607 for 6 math packages APPROVED
 - Sarah Schraml (3rd Grade) \$1,507 for supplemental books to assist with the new Benchmark program – APPROVED
 - Kristie Krier (Vice Principal) \$820 for 4 staff to attend the CCIRA literacy conference in Feb 2022 APPROVED
- Erin presented one grant request from Yvette Wieter (4th grade) that we voted to partially approve. Yvette asked for books and décor to create a "reading room" in her mobile. We voted to approve \$115 to cover the cost of books. We will suggest to her that she receive donations from parents for the décor and accessories.
- Erin presented one grant request that we decided not to approve, at this time. It's from Bonnie Apol (PE). She's requesting \$1,250 for a TV, Apple TV, mounting & case. We didn't feel this was a completely necessary expense right now, but will revisit it after we've received all other grant requests for the year. Also, we believe this large of an equipment purchase may need to go through the school first.
- All the approved grants, plus the \$150 for Hawk's Nest previously approved, came to \$5,500. This is aligned well with our \$7,000 budget, which we can always increase, if needed.

- We'd like to do a community clean-up day on Saturday, Nov. 13th. We can do a sign-up genius with certain spots to fill for various projects. We can also encourage people to do their area on a day that is more convenient for them. (We will do another clean-up day in the Spring.) Areas needing cleaning up include:
 - Pulling up weeds
 - o Painting our symbol on the outside mobile
 - Painting the doors
 - Trash pick-up
 - Rock Garden
 - o Behind the shed hide the electrical box area
